FORTY-SECOND ANNUAL REPORT.

TO THE MEMBERS OF THE
CARLTON FOOTBALL CLUB.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,

Your Committee has the honour to present to you their Annual Report and Balance Sheet for Season 1906, together with a record of the team's performances.

Position of Club.

After a lapse of nineteen years, the Club has once again attained the highest possible honours in the football world, by winning the League Premiership in the most strenuous and brilliant season in the annals of the game. Nineteen matches were played, sixteen of which were won and three lost. The record is an excellent one, especially considering the great sustained pace of modern football—for "it's the pace that kills"—and the unavoidable accidents incidental to the game. It is almost an impossibility for a side under existing conditions to go through a season without sustaining a defeat.

Carlton's win was an extremely popular one, congratulatory messages being received from all parts of Victoria, from every State in the Commonwealth, and from New Zealand and South Africa. There was a record attendance at the final match, the enormous attendance of 44,437 being the greatest concourse of people at any football match in Australasia. And the play was worthy of the occasion, the salient and intricate

points of the game being up to the highest standard, the accurate kicking of your representatives being quite the feature of the play.

Fitzroy, our doughty and worthy opponents, took their defeat like true sportsmen. The Captain (Mr. E. Jenkins) and the Secretary (Mr. C. M. Hickey), while, naturally, lamenting the fact that the honours of the season did not fall to their lot, warmly congratulated Carlton upon their success, stating that, upon the season's form, the best team had undoubtedly won the Premiership.

The players are deserving of the warmest thanks of the members for their magnificent and brilliantly-sustained efforts throughout the season. They were splendidly led by their deservedly popular commander, Mr. J. Flynn, able assistance being also rendered by the Vice-Captain, Mr. G. Bruce. In the opinion of many experts, no finer or fitter team ever contested the State's Premiership. It is worthy of note to record the fact that the Club was not displaced from the first position on the honour list during the season.

Naturally, the prospects of the coming season are of a most encouraging nature, all last season's players being available. As the great majority of the team have all their football in front of them—in fact, four first season colts participated in the final match, and all of them under 21 years of age—there is every reason to look hopefully forward to the coming season. For now that the sweets of victory have been enjoyed, every legitimate effort will be made so that the Club will maintain its present proud position.

Owing to the dashing play of the team, and to the successful management, the membership has, as a natural corollary, increased greatly, numbering, all told, the satisfactory total of 2811, an increase of 316 from the previous season. The list is as follows:—Members, 2447; Ladies and Boys, 364. The membership is an easy record so far as the Club is concerned, the increase during the last five years being simply extraordinary, amounting to no less a number than 2339. "There's nothing succeeds like success."

The finances of the Club are in a highly satisfactory condition, especially when it is taken into consideration that the Ground Committee received the large amount of £729, and the players were given a trip to Sydney, besides numerous social entertainments. There is a credit balance of £34 7s. 8d.

Trips.

After the termination of the season the players were taken to Sydney for a holiday, an outing that was well earned. A match against Combined N.S.W. was won by your representatives by 9 goals to 6, after a most interesting contest. There was some excellent material in the ranks of the Sydney men, the principal defect being the lack of innate knowledge of the fine points of the game. With the schoolboys coming on, there is every reason to feel confident that N.S.W. will possess a fine combination in a few years' time. The members of the N.S.W. League, headed by their esteemed President, Mr. A. E. Nash, and the Secretary, Mr. Chesney Harte, did everything in their power towards making the visit of the Carltonians a pleasant one. Their efforts were eminently successful. The glories of their beautiful harbour were greatly appreciated by the visitors, who one and all thoroughly enjoyed themselves. The team was under the management of your Secretary, Mr. John Worrall. Upon returning home, the Captain of the team, on behalf of the players and others who undertook the trip, presented the Manager with a handsome set of carvers and serviette rings, in recognition of his efforts on their behalf while on tour.

Your Committee entertained the Norwood F.C., who were over from Adelaide on a visit to Victoria, to a drag picnic to Beaumaris, which was thoroughly enjoyed both by the visitors and our own players.

Next Season's Trips.

The fame of your Club, owing to its splendid success last season, has been the direct means of several invitations being extended from different parts of the Union during the currency

of the coming football year. One is from the Tasmanian Football League, to journey (in conjunction with the South Melbourne F.C.) to the southern island to play an Exhibition Match in June next. Football is on the upward grade in Tasmania, and the local authorities are strongly of opinion that a match between such old rivals would put the game in Tasmania on a sound and lasting footing. Carlton would be only too pleased to have the famous Red and Whites for company.

Another is from the West Australian and Goldfields' Football Associations, who have extended a hearty invitation to your Club to visit the West at the end of the next football season. The trip altogether will occupy about five weeks, four matches to be played—three on the coast and one on the fields. The idea is for your Club to leave Melbourne immediately after the final match, play Fremantle on the following Saturday, Perth on the Wednesday, and combined Coast on the next Saturday. On the following Saturday a Combined Goldfields team to be met at Kalgoorlie, and thence back to the coast and home. The projected trip is a unique one, for no Victorian team has as yet visited the West. Your Committee strongly recommends to the incoming Committee the desirability of undertaking the West Australian trip if possible.

Social.

The Ladies' Tea Committee, comprising Mesdames A. Urquhart, Mills, Elliott, and Worrall, and Misses Foley, Croft, Madden, and Norris, gave their usual Annual Ball to the players and executive. It was a brilliant success, and was greatly enjoyed by the large number present. The ladies also tendered the players two Euchre Parties and a drag picnic to Aspendale, all of which were pronounced successes. These ladies are deserving of the members' warmest thanks.

To celebrate the winning of the Premiership, the President of the Club (Mr. M. F. Evans) entertained the players, Executive, and personal friends at a smoke night in the

Manchester Unity Hall. The event was a distinct success, and greatly enjoyed by the large gathering present.

Mr. W. Heatley, of the Red Lion Hotel, Carlton, also gave the players and Committee a smoke night to commemorate the Premiership. A most enjoyable evening was spent. The host and hostess took advantage of the occasion to present to Mr. J. Flynn a handsome gold medal as a memento of his successful captainship.

Upon the termination of the season your esteemed and worthy player, Mr. Fred Elliott, joined the ranks of the Benedicts. The Committee, on behalf of the Club, suitably marked the occasion by the presentation of a cheque, the individual members of the Executive doing likewise, while the players presented their popular comrade with a handsome gold chain and sovereign purse.

Australasian Football Conference.

In November last a meeting took place in Melbourne of representatives of all the States of the Commonwealth and New Zealand to form an Australasian Football Council. The objects of the Council are for the purpose of the promotion and advancement of the Australasian game of football. Every controlling body represented on the Council shall play under absolutely the same laws, no kicking in the so-called ruck in one place and not in another. It was carried unanimously: "That in the opinion of this Council it is desirable that the various States and New Zealand compete for the Australasian Football Championship in 1908, and that such contests be held in Melbourne about the end of August." Great interest and keenness has been aroused in West Australia, South Australia, Tasmania, Queensland, New South Wales and New Zealand over the proposed pan-Australasian fortnight fixture, which will certainly mark an epoch in the history of the national game, for that it is the national game admits of no doubt, for it possesses more devotees than any

other pastime in the Commonwealth. Such a meeting will also tend to foster a healthy national spirit. The League's representatives to the Council were Messrs. C. M. Hickey and John Worrall.

Proposed Grand Stand.

As a great deal of confusion exists amongst the members regarding the building of the proposed Grand Stand, your Committee wishes to explain the position in as brief a manner as possible. According to the rules governing the ground, a committee, called the Ground Committee, is appointed from the Football and Cricket Clubs, of three members each, with power to elect their own Chairman. The ground is vested in the Presidents of the two Clubs (as appointed by the City Council and the Board of Land and Works), who shall have a general controlling power for the purpose of enforcing the due observance of the Ground Committee's conditions and rules.

Rule 5 reads: "That one-third of all net profits derived from matches played on the ground . . . shall be retained by the Ground Committee."

Rule 7 reads: "That all moneys retained by the Ground Committee under the above rule shall be expended by it for the *general improvement and maintenance of the ground and for the convenience of the members of both Clubs and the general public.*"

It will thus be seen that the erection of a Grand Stand rests entirely in the hands of the Ground Committee, not in the hands of the Football Club, as is erroneously understood by the members.

Every penny received by the Ground Committee for the upkeep of the ground is derived from football, the responsibility of maintaining the ground resting entirely upon the prowess of the Football Club. Just to show to the members the monetary assistance rendered to the Ground Committee during the last five years from football matches alone, for

improvements to the ground, the following figures will be instructive, viz. :—

Your Club was represented on the League by Messrs. J. H. Chapman and John Worrall, and the thanks of the Club are due to these gentlemen for the efficient manner in which they safeguarded the interests of the Club and the game in general.

Mr. J. Flynn, the Captain of the Club, was presented by Mr. C. Hickey, on behalf of the League, with the ball used in the final match, which was suitably inscribed by your Committee.

The members will be gratified to know that Messrs. A. Snell and M. Gotz, who received injuries during last season, have quite recovered, and will don the colors during the coming year.

A musical programme, under the able management of Mr. S. Quirk, will be provided by popular performers.

The members of the Ground Committee—your nominees being Messrs. W. F. Evans, W. Broatch, and J. R. Mills—performed arduous work during the season.

This Committee wishes to express its satisfaction with the able manner in which the Hon. Secretary (Mr. John Worrall) performed his secretarial duties throughout the year, and especially for the eminent manner in which your Secretary managed the Sydney trip.

And this Committee also wishes to place on record the efficient manner your Hon. Treasurer (Mr. J. Urquhart) performed his duties.
